Your admission is conditional pending our receipt of official final academic records from your previous institution(s). (Uploaded and e-mailed documents are not official.) Final records must be received by our office before you will be allowed to enroll in classes at lowa State. If you are a current ISU student, this will be handled internally for you. If you anticipate any difficulties in meeting these requirements, please contact the Office of Admissions for assistance. You can reference information regarding official academic records on the enclosed Official Academic Record Information Sheet.

- If your studies are complete, please contact the Registrar at your previous school(s) and arrange to have official records, including degree certificates, mailed to the Office of Admissions.
