Compulsory Course of Community engagement for first year students

For the Academic Year 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24 approximately 2000 students took this course.

Supplementary : Approval of Mandatory Course for every 1st or 2nd year
Agenda 29.18 UG student of University on Community Engagement
(Mentoring School Students) for 2 credits.

It was submitted to the Academic Council that to achieve the objectives of socio-economic development of New India, Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) can play an important role through active community engagement. Towards this, the UGC has prepared National Curriculum framework & Guidelines for Fostering Social Responsibility & Community Engagement in Higher Educational Institutes in India. The frame work recommends that each HEI conduct a compulsory course to provide community engagement of all UG & PG students. Proposed credit-based for students: Participation of students in teaching activities of community engagement and research projects and learning should earn them credits. Community engagement should thus be included to meet their graduation requirements and it should be Integrated into their assessments

Hence, it was proposed to start:

- (I) Mandatory Course on Community Engagement (Mentoring School Students) of 2 extra Credits (Over and above the credit required for graduation) for UG students of 1st or 2nd year and adopt absolute grading system.
- (II) The minimum duration of the course will be one years. There will be continuous evaluation and final credit will be given at the end of academic year on which course have been opted by students.

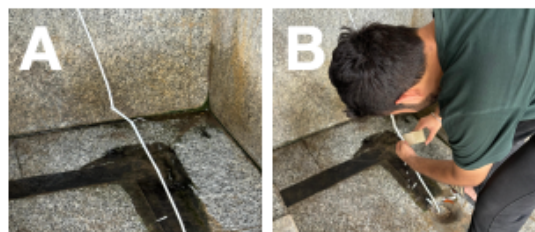


Figure A: Water leakage near water cooler & Figure B: Repairing the leakage

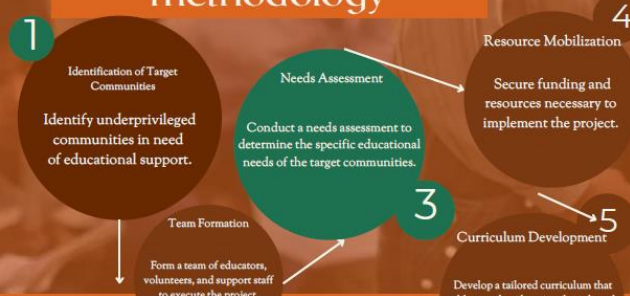

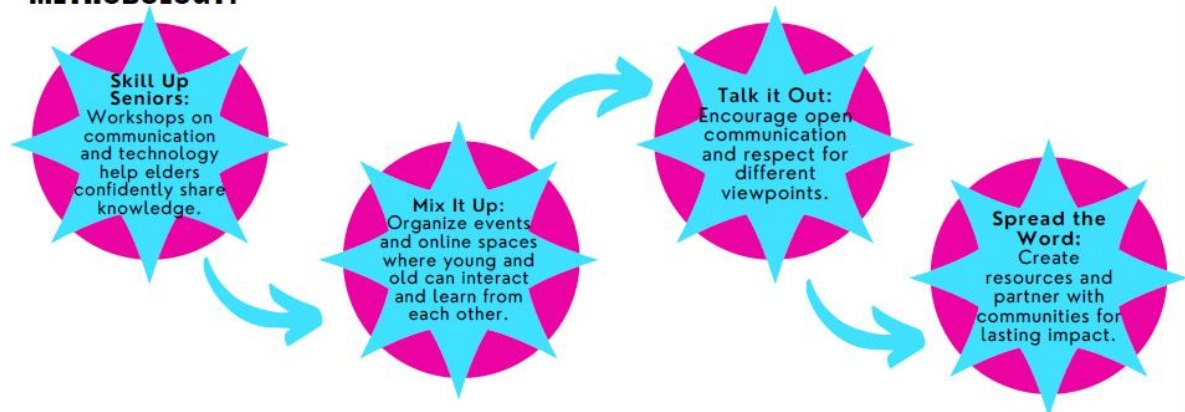

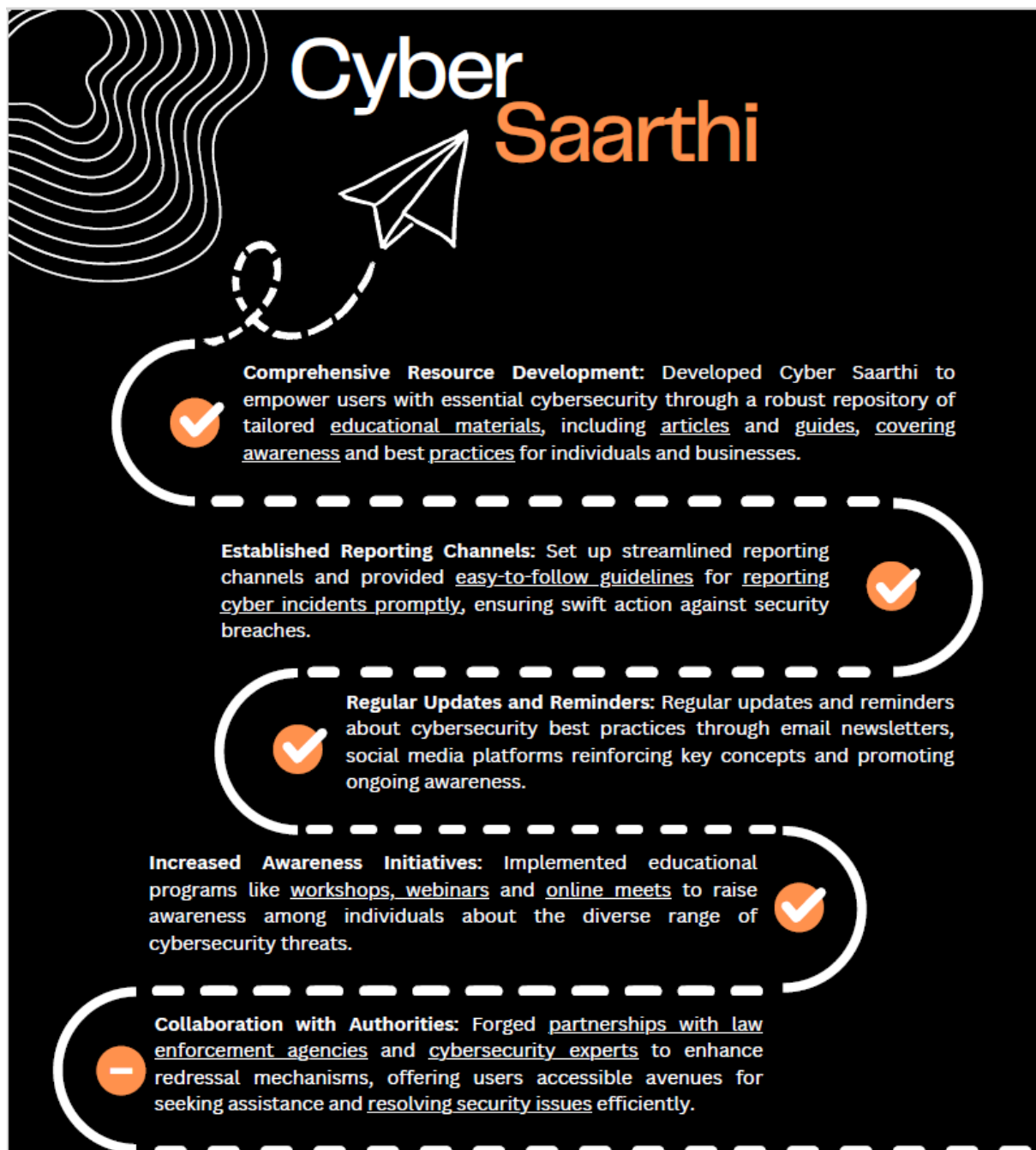

01 INTRODUCTION

In India, villages are rife with baseless and false superstitions concerning menstruation. Women are often deemed impure during their menstrual cycle, perpetuating harmful stereotypes. To combat this, we visited an NGO in an attempt to dismantle some of these misconceptions.



02 OBJECTIVES

- Analyzing the ground situation in slums

- Consequently, they avoid household chores and cooking.
- They feel hesitant and ashamed to share their problems, emotional struggles, and physical pain with us.
- Due to inadequate facilities such as clean water and toilets, hygiene standards are not satisfactory.
- Young girls still lack sufficient education about menstruation.


