## ISO TRAINING FOR AUDITORS

At Delhi Technological University, the academic and administrative processes are driven by the pillars of quality. There is a quest for continuous improvement. The University is ISO 9001:2015 certified since 27.11.2018. The international Standard specifies requirements for a quality management system when an organization: a) needs to demonstrate its ability to consistently provide products and services that meet customer and applicable statutory and regulatory requirements, and b) aims to enhance customer satisfaction through the effective application of the system, including processes for improvement of the system and the assurance of conformity to customer and applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.

To strengthen the University's ability for continuous improvement, an ISO 9001:2015 Internal QMS Auditor Training Course was conducted from 19 to 21 July 2023 by the University. The training program for 14 DTU faculty/officers was in collaboration with STQC, Directorate, Govt. of India.

The following list of documents is included in the ISO training for auditors:

1. **QMS Profile Document:** This outlines the Quality Management System's structure and key elements specific to the organization.
2. **Process for Control of Documented Information:** This document details how information is created, reviewed, updated, and archived to ensure integrity and accessibility.
3. **Process for Purchasing:** This outlines the procedures for acquiring goods and services, ensuring that they meet specified quality requirements.
4. **Process for Internal Audit:** This document describes the framework for conducting internal audits, including planning, execution, reporting, and follow-up actions.

These documents are essential for understanding and implementing effective quality management practices and ensuring compliance with ISO standards.
