



Lab on wheels to give joy of learning in remote areas

New Delhi: To make with education a mass movement, educational institutions will be set to set minimum bench marks of learning, deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia said on Tuesday. He was addressing an event held to mark the launch of Delhi Technological University's Lab-on-wheels programme.

Sisodia said, "The programme will bring joy of learning to students in remote areas."

The mobile lab is a customised bus with 17 computers, two televisions, one 3D printer, cameras and one projector. The aim is to impart education to students of all sections, said AK Srivastava, associate dean of Centre of Extension and Field Outreach at DTU.

Students of DTU will be deployed in the bus to teach children of Delhi government schools. Eighteen schools have collaborated with DTU to participate in the outreach programme for guiding students in the domains of mathematics and science.

Sisodia said, "Through work on the project, we are determined to increase the relevance of education for our students. Our students will conduct classes for government school students and teach them by using peer learning helps."

since the gap between us and the school students isn't much, it will be easier to teach them. Our plan is to assist them in learning powerpoint and software, as well as to teach them how to use the internet. Many of these students do not have a PC or laptop.

Apart from launching the lab, Sisodia also inaugurated a classroom complex and unveiled the department of design at DTU.

Speaking about the mobile lab programme, Sisodia said,

"It is our dream that our nation adopts various unique and innovative approaches in the field of engineering. The introduction of modern engin-

ering courses at DTU will be relevant for the progress of our nation in the next 10 years."

The deputy CM added, "Delhi government is planning to start an initiative to encourage students of Delhi government schools to fulfil their dreams and stand on their feet. I appreciate the volunteers of DTU who will help 44 Delhi government school students fulfil their dreams, improve and realise their dreams. I urge all the 14,000 students of DTU to become mentors for at least one student each, so that students of Delhi government schools can receive the best guidance to become future leaders."





7.1.8 Describe the Institutional efforts/initiatives in providing an inclusive environment i.e. tolerance and harmony towards cultural, regional, linguistic, communal, Socio - economic and other diversities (within a maximum of 200 words)

Apart from working for the development of the 5 adopted villages under Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan, the Centre of Extension and Field Outreach (OEA) is continuing its efforts to maintain the conduct of the Desh ke Mentors Program by offering a compulsory credit course on community Engagement Courses (MSS). The University, through OEA-DTU, has played its role in society by helping and educating the masses to maintain their well-being during the COVID-19 pandemic; in this regard, it has conducted various events such as "COVID-19 ki awadhi me swasthya prabandh (Mahilao ke Sandarbh me): COVID-19 ke dauran apne sharir ki gatishilta kaise banaye rakhe" and "Corona: Challenges & Solutions" in Jun'21 and Jan'22 respectively. Uptaking the religious route, the University conducted a national webinar on Bhagwat Gita: The art of Living" in Jan'22. A webinar on Prospects of nanomaterials modified conducting paper-based biosensors for cancer detection was conducted in Jun'21. DTU, through OEA, also promotes regional development by enabling students to visit its facilities for school students to develop an interest in science and engineering. It has worked to improve computer literacy by conducting Basic Computer Training under Skill Development Program for Juveniles, and weaker sections in Rohini District attended by 26 juveniles through its Lab-on-Wheels initiative.

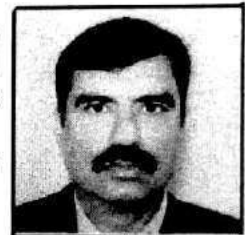
