Outcomes:

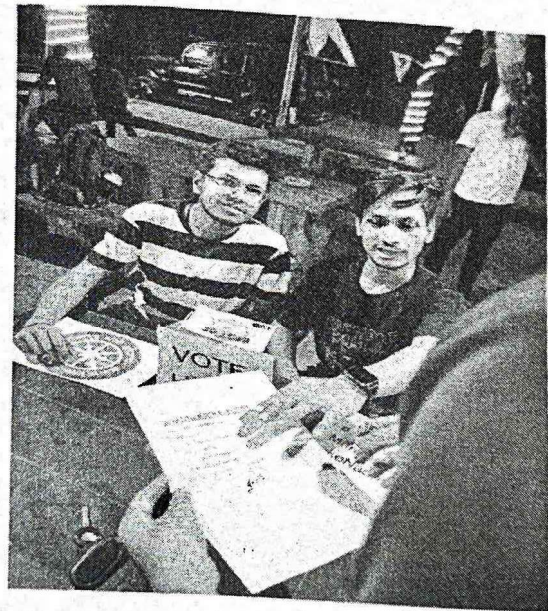
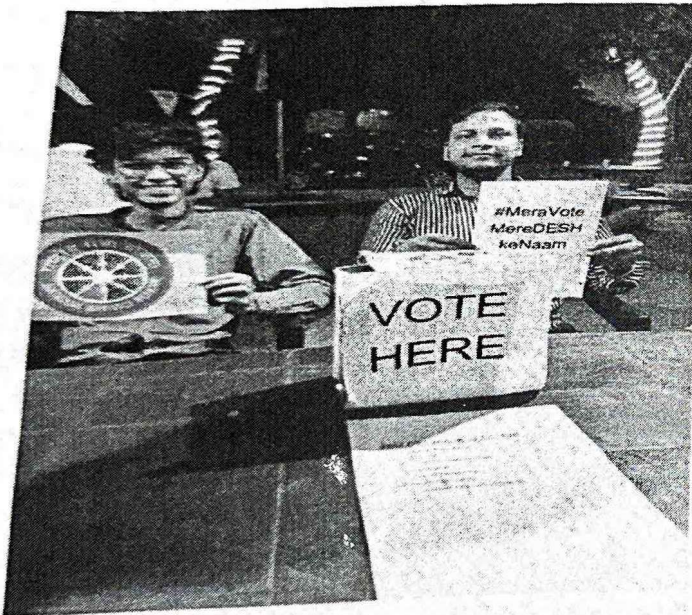
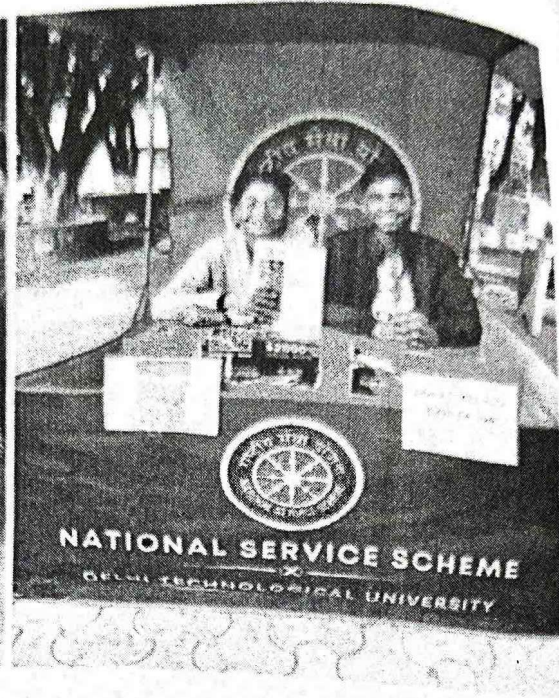
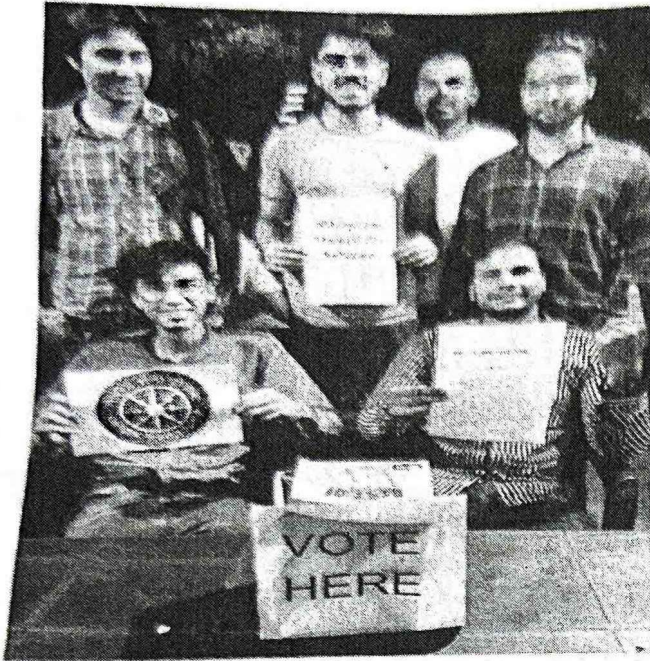
- Increased awareness and understanding of the electoral process among students.

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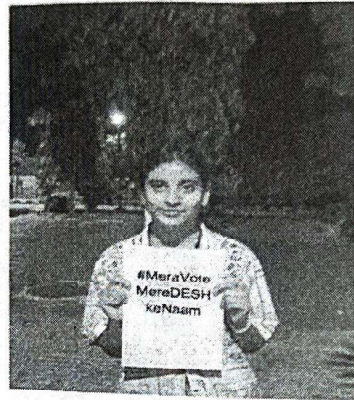
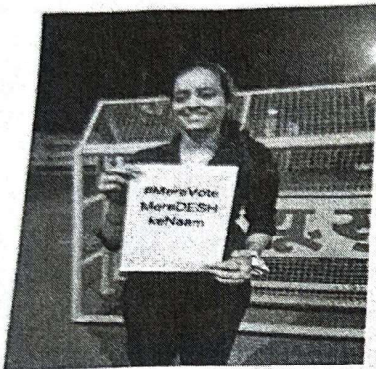
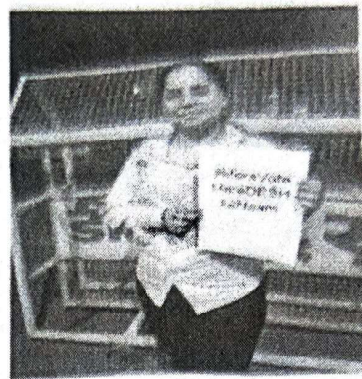

Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) Events Report

Amidst the evolving landscape of democratic challenges and opportunities, NSS-DTU took proactive measures to enhance electoral literacy among students through the establishment of Electoral Literacy Club on 22nd February 2024. The club served as vibrant platforms for students to engage in discussions, workshops, and outreach activities aimed at deepening their understanding of the electoral process and civic responsibilities. ELC has been characterized by representation from diverse student demographics and faculty members, ensuring a holistic approach to electoral education. The formation of the club fostered a sense of community and empowered students to become agents of change within their campuses.

Programs and Initiatives by ELCs:

1. **Awareness Camp:** On 5-6th March 2024, ELC organized “**Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye**” campaign to educate first time voters about electoral role and the significance of voting. Through this initiative, the ELC sought to instill a sense of responsibility and civic duty among students, inspiring them to actively participate in the electoral process and contribute to nation-building.
2. **Electoral Education Workshop for staff and security guards:** To demystify the electoral process, ELC conducted an interactive workshop on 25th April 2024 for official staff members and security guards of Delhi Technological University. The workshop aimed to provide essential knowledge about electoral processes, voter rights, and responsibilities, thereby empowering participants to actively engage in the democratic process.
3. **Mock Elections:** On April 4, 2024, ELC organized mock elections as experiential learning opportunities for students. These simulations included mock debates, candidate forums, and polling booths, providing practical insights into campaigning strategies and voter behavior.
4. **Institutionalizing Mechanisms for Voter Registration:** In pursuit of promoting democratic engagement and fostering electoral literacy among students, the Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) of NSS-DTU undertook proactive steps to institutionalize mechanisms for voter registration. Recognizing the importance of active participation in the electoral process, the ELC spearheaded efforts to ensure that eligible students above the age of 18 were duly enrolled as voters.

The ELC initiated the following steps to facilitate voter registration among students:


1. **Data Collection via Google Form:** The ELC employed a Google Form to collect information from students. This form served as a convenient platform for students to provide their details, including their age and eligibility for voter registration.
2. **Identification of Eligible Students:** Through the data collected via the Google Form, the ELC identified students above the age of 18 who were not yet enrolled as voters. This crucial step enabled targeted outreach efforts to ensure maximum participation in the voter registration process.
3. **Collaboration with Election Authorities:** The ELC worked closely with election authorities to establish voter registration process. These centers provided convenient access for students to register as voters without having to navigate bureaucratic hurdles or logistical challenges.
4. **Facilitation of Voter Registration Process:** Through effective coordination with election authorities, the ELC facilitated the voter registration process through ECI Voter Registration Portal. Volunteers provided guidance and assistance to students, ensuring a smooth and seamless registration experience.

Conclusion

The initiatives undertaken by NSS-DTU, particularly through representative Electoral Literacy Club, underscored the commitment to inculcate politically informed and engaged citizens. With a focus on enhancing the participation of underprivileged sections and institutionalizing mechanisms for voter registration, these initiatives not only promoted electoral literacy but also advocated for inclusivity and democratic participation within university campuses. Looking back, this initiative marked a significant milestone in the journey towards empowering tomorrow's voters and advancing democratic values.



Constitutional Safeguards to the Govt. Servants.

Article 311. Dismissal, removal or reduction in rank of persons employed in civil capacity in the Union or a State.

(1) No person employed in a civil capacity in the Union or in a State shall be dismissed or removed or reduced in rank without the authority of a competent authority.

(2) No such authority shall be exercised in the case of a person employed in a civil capacity in the Union or in a State until he has been informed of the charges against him and given an opportunity of being heard in respect of those charges.

(3) No such authority shall be exercised in the case of a person employed in a civil capacity in the Union or in a State until he has been given an opportunity of being heard in respect of those charges.

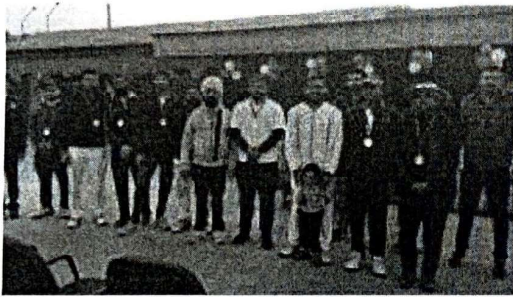


Figure 7 DTU faculty team being awarded with silver Medal

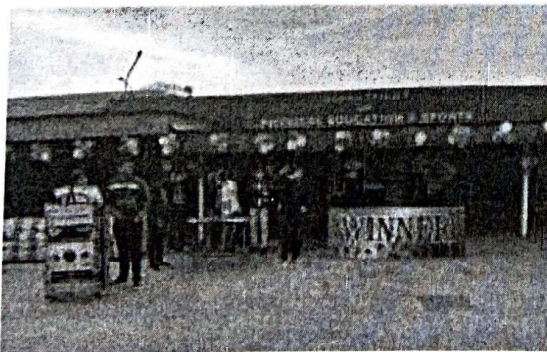


Figure 4 Preparation of the closing ceremony for the event Republic Day

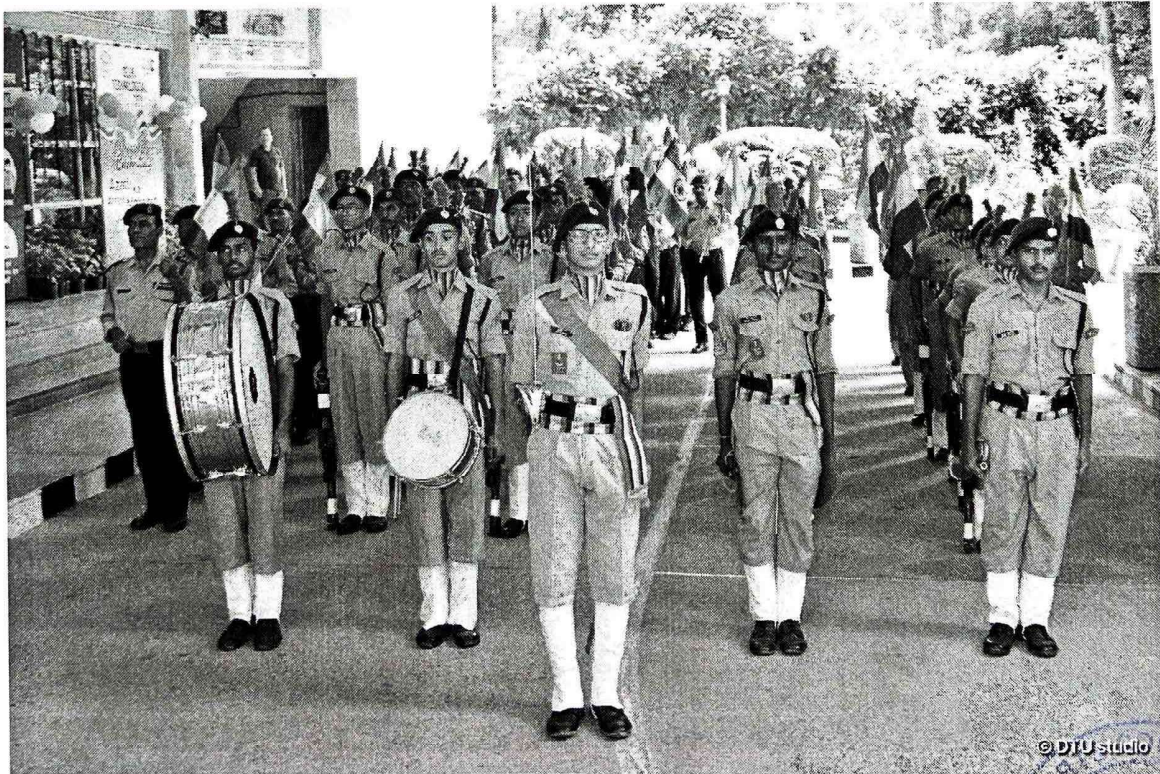

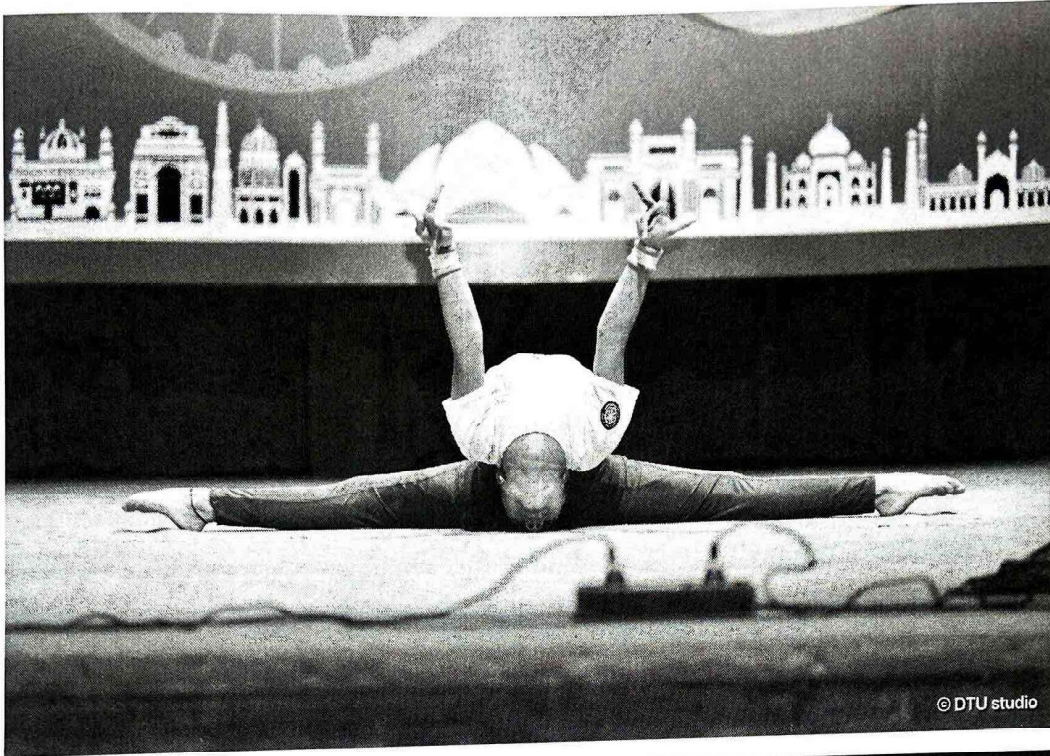

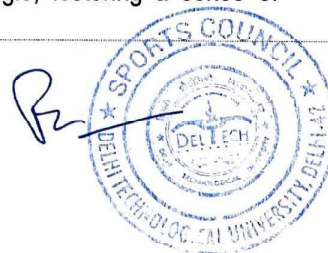

Details of Course:

This course is designed as practical course and therefore no regular classes will be conducted. However, few classes will be conducted on following topics: Starting small business, planning, organizing, and managing human resources. Additionally, few motivational lectures in the form of success stories will be conducted for the students.

A group of maximum two students who registers for this course will be given an initial seed money upto Rs 10,000/- to start a small business. This will help students in realizing their entrepreneurship potential. The student will submit a Business Plan in the first week of the commencement of academic session. A group of maximum two (02) students can register for this elective at the beginning of I-III semester. The registered student/team should conceptualize a business idea and submit a proposal in the prescribed format in the office of Dean (UG) within 1st week of commencement of semester registration. A Mentor Committee, comprising of (i) Chairperson(s) (ii) A faculty member/course coordinator and (iii) External expert will approve/reject proposals based on the merits and expected outcome of the proposal.

The same committee may also assign the maximum possible grades for the course. The student shall submit a detailed project report at the end semester for evaluation.

The University will not be responsible for loss beyond the seed money. However, the profit will be divided proportionally.

Benefits of Plant-Based diet





The responsible feeding and deworming of community dogs



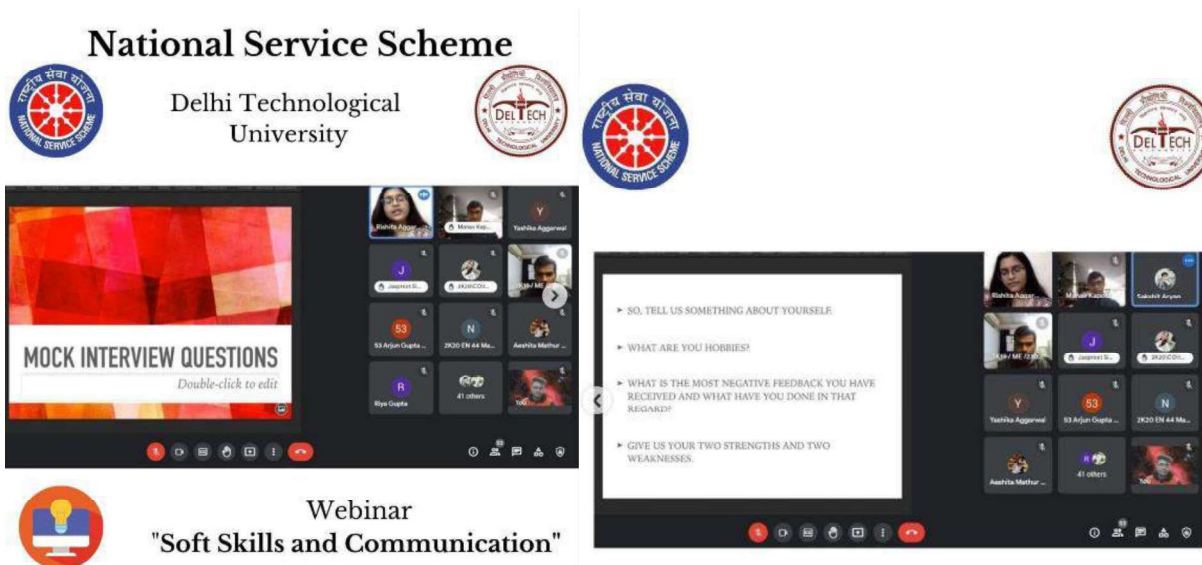



Road Safety Awareness


